The meaning of social planning can be well illustrated in painting. An artist is a sensitive man, who has the power of perceiving the metaphysical forces in Nature, or his environment. The abstract as such is given to him from the outside, which he Exptuses, accepts, tinderstands, emotionally that is and with this, the feeling, he sits to paint, to give a physical reality to this feeling, which is the meaning, the reason for the physical outgrath.]

By fully understanding the meaning of the emotion, he can detach himself from the state of perception, and give himself to the state of exprescreation. He is no longer translating, now he is planning, measuring, applying technique, mixing color,. This thisge he knows through practice, and trial and error and study.

Society is the result of an abstract need of man,. The need is like the need for painting, for expressing a force. If men at perceiving this emotion this need for the creation of society, and would translate literally, still in the emotional state, without intellectualizing, thinking planning, what would be the result? It would probably result into frantic grouping of individuals, piling against each other. A man would run, when cold weather struck, to a group and would use their bodies for warmth. He might attempt to eat another man, or maybe we any to feel the integration with the other body, This is the emotional need alright, but societies through history have been And entirely different things. Why?. Because man has the power of intellect, he has memory, and before all, he is a creator.

In social planning as in art, unfortunately there are only a few who have the keen sense of perception of the metaphysical forces, and only they are able to capture the meanings, and create with them a piece of art.

Since early societies, they had theer artists, theer head planners, their creators. In these times there was appreciation for the individuals who had emotional contacts with Nature, who could understand it. And these men had power because they were superior. Today, society is so large, and complex, and status has become the result. of personality, not of individuality, and x sensitive need there is no recognition of sensitiveness, of artistry. Why are we like this today? Because of the planning like painting has been done brough only a momentary emotional need to express, and no intellectual understanding was ared. There was a feeling and a portraiture of the feeling of the need, with no conception of the final result. Or maybe because in planning, like in painting, the expression was donne by an insensitive ma who happened to have the power but not the capabilities.

We could say then that sociate planning is the intellectual process of thinking in orderly and efficient manner to bring the needs of men as groups into an artistic and unified whole.

Society has many facerts like a painting has many lines. Each face in society should as each line in mixert the painting, have its own character, and strenght, and purpose, and at the same time carry within, the meaning of the whole to which they belong.

Social planning has to be able to visualize the whole, and have complete mastery of details, and techniques, and having an overall picture, dedicate its efforts to make each part of society meaningful, and integral with the whole of society.

Another step which is involved in the creation of a piece of art is the squematic study of the whole, a study of the proportions which emerge from the grouping of the elements, andhere is where architectural creation is more closely related to social planning.

In architecture, the step of creation is done in paper. The visualization

hat to be three dimentional through, and the proportions, are conceived in three and four dimentions, time included, while they are shown in a two dimentional plane.

Society is more than three dimentional, and the whole has to be visualized in all its dimentions, while planning for it.

Each part of siciety has to be considered by the planner like each beam and lintel is considered by the architect to carry the whole structure. These steps which we have considered are what I would call the planning of the planning. After these steps in perception, and intellectualization of the idea into a visualized shape, comes the ingeneering of the plan. In this step the plan has not yet been put to work, since it is not ready yet. The planned whole, has now to be studied, to see whether the parts will do their job. A wide knowledge of the forces which might be applied to the structure, has is necessary, to see whether the structure will hold its shape and integrity through the stresses and strains produced by foreighn forces or internal forces, created by one part against are nother. After the engineering of the pla is done, then is when the artist takes over again, and see whether the meaning, the soul, if you please, of the creation has been violated for the sake of safe structure. And the artistic meaning can not be violated if it was trully conceived and honestly expressed.

Then, and only then can be plan come to physical life, then can it be applied to man, because man was the e seentid part in the abstract perception of the origin, and he is an exsential part in its physical reality.

The structure has b be one with the meaning and the artistic expression.
