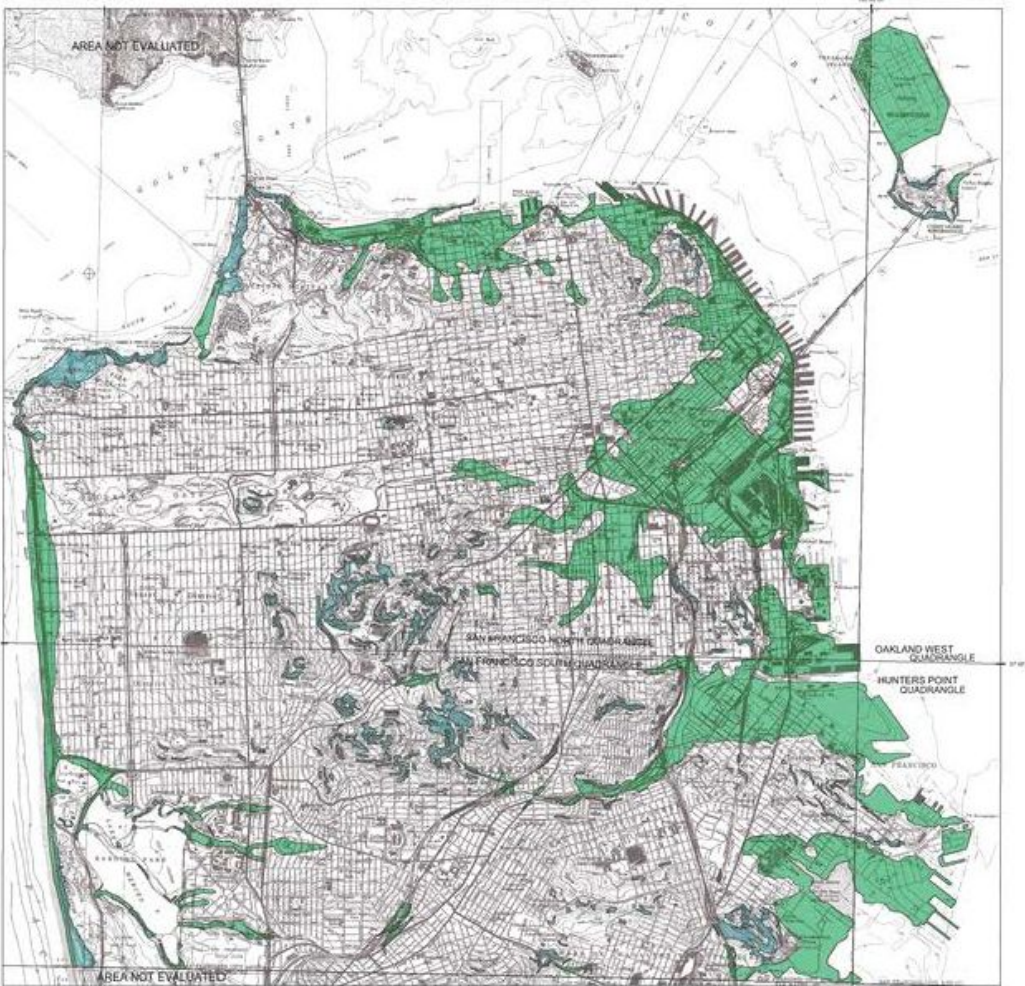




PURPOSE OF MAP
